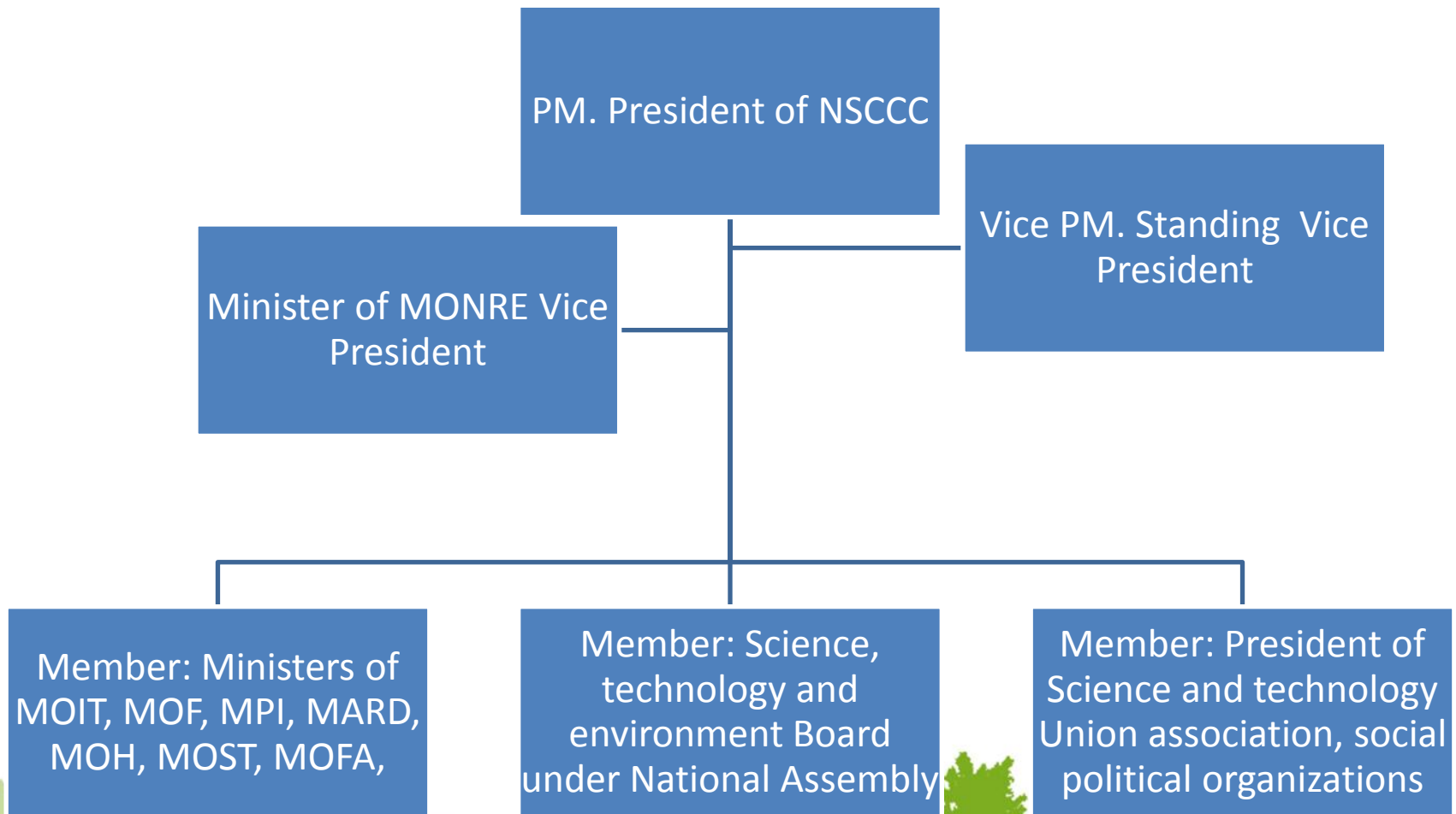

1. Organisation of National Steering committee on climate change (NSCCCC)



Mandate of NSCCC

- Consultation on Climate change issues according to interdisciplinary for Gov't and PM
- Coordinating line Ministries over come the important duties and moderate all existing related programs, strategies such as NTP for EE, CP, GGS, RED+,...
- Consultation on long, medium term solution to respond to climate change for the Gov't
- International cooperation in climate change
- Consultation on policies advisory

2. Role of relevant Government Agencies for GG implementation

- Ministry of Planning and Investment (MPI)
 - Formulate master plan and strategy about green growth
 - Moderating international supports to respond to CC including GGS
 - **National Office for GGS implementation in Vietnam under NSCCC.**
 - Coordinating ministries' activities relating to GG

2. Role of relevant Government Agencies for GG implementation (cont)

- Ministry of Industry and Trade
 - Renewable energy development
 - NTP for EE implementation and EE Law
 - Cleaner production
 - Bio diesel project
 - Green industry
 - Low carbon development strategy on energy, industries such as steel, chemical, beer, alcohol, garment& textile, paper,...

3. Role of relevant Government Agencies for GG implementation (cont)

- Ministry of transport
 - Green transportation
 - Alternate fuel for means of transportations
- Ministry of agriculture and rural Development:
 - GHG reduction by REDD and REDD+
 - GHG reduction by smart agriculture facilities
 - GHG reduction by changing cultivation and planting,...

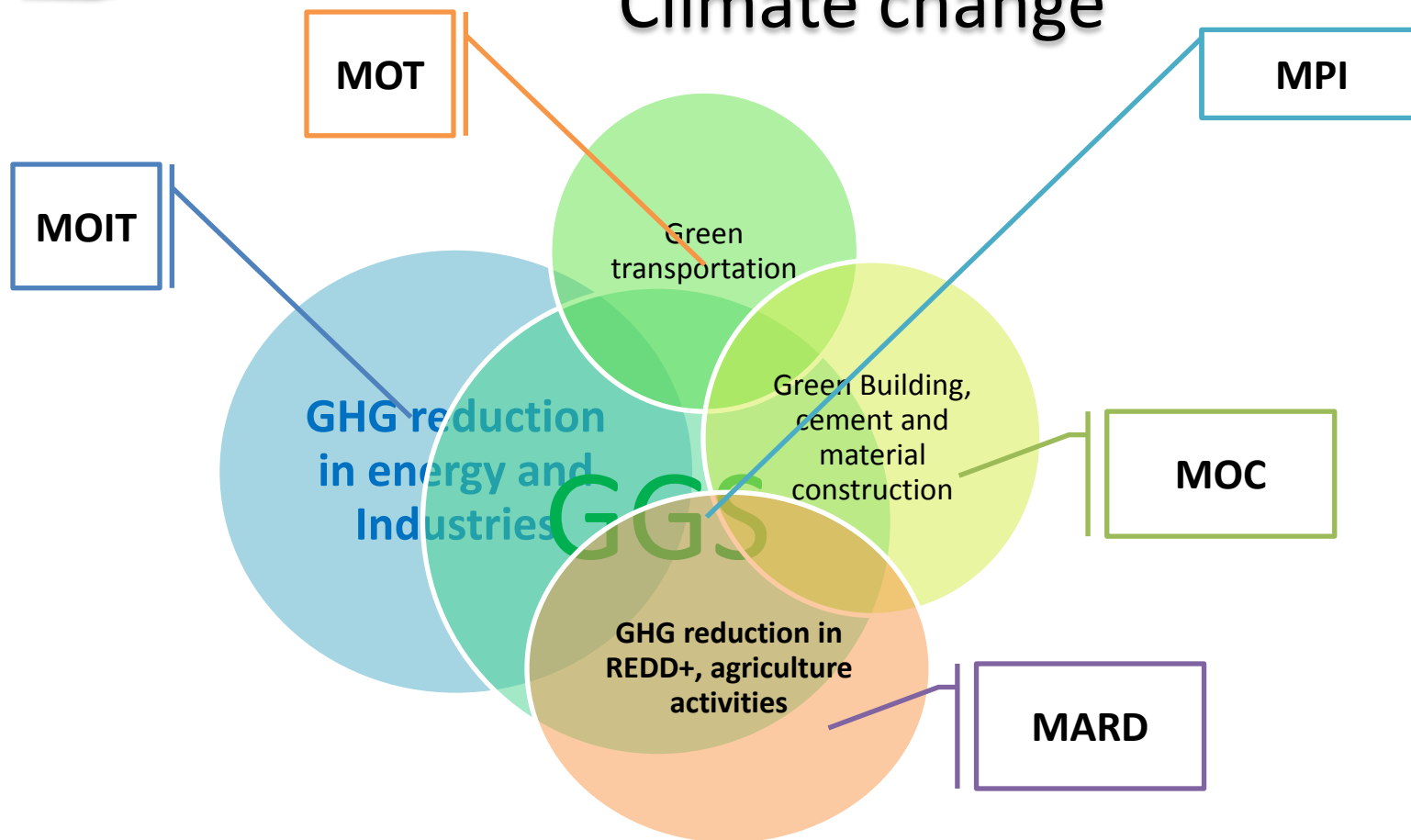
2. Role of relevant Government Agencies for GG implementation (cont)

- Ministry of Construction
 - Low carbon building
 - Low carbon on cement industry and material construction
 - ,...
- Ministry of Natural resources and Environment
 - National focal point of climate change issues
 - Supporting national GHG reduction in the whole country and DNA of UNFCCC
 - Supporting all activities related to CC in the line ministries

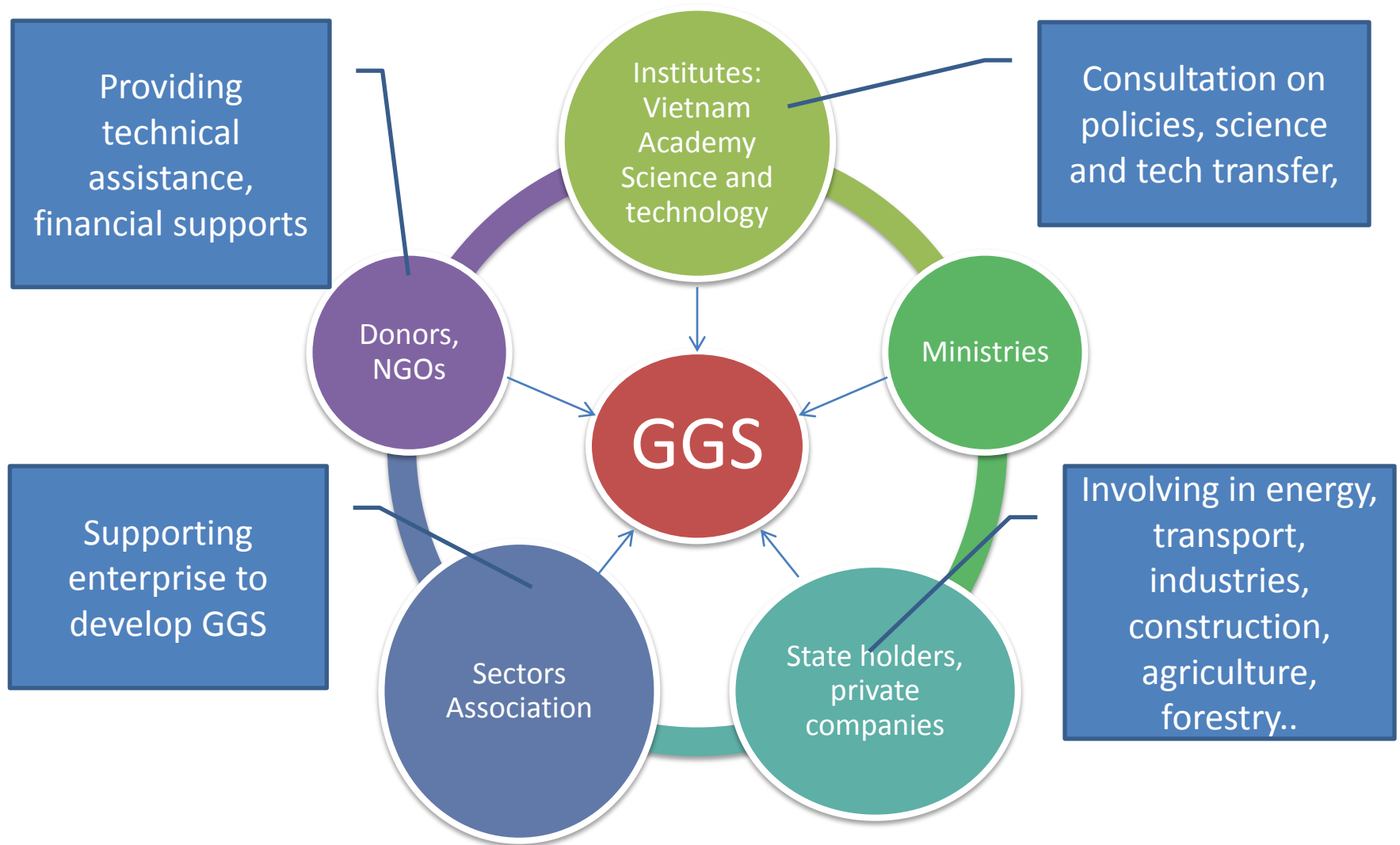

4. Coordination for GGS implementation

- NSCCC: Head by Prime Minister, members are Ministers.
- Under CC umbrella: chair by MONRE
- GGS under CC issue: chair by MPI and with important contribution from MOIT, MOT, MARD,...
- Line ministries work together under the direction of NSCCC

5. Challenges

- Capacity and experience is limited both national and provincial level
- Poor awareness of GG in community
- Lack of mechanism for encouraging and promoting private sectors go green: education, technology transfer and development
- Responsibilities of Line Ministries is not clear enough for GGS targets

6. Recommendations

- For regional: Establish a network in the world and region scale to support developing countries to implement GGS, firstly in capacity building, awareness raising, technology transfer, consultations, experiences sharing,...
- For Vietnam:
 - Clearly assignment of line ministries to address the targets of GGS and regular report to permanence Ministry of GG
 - Encouraging and promoting the involvement of private sectors by incentives, R&D by Trust Fund, Science Fund with specific criteria that support green projects or capacity building activities
