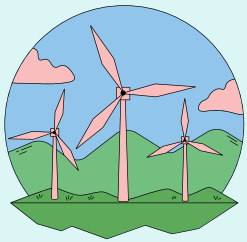




GREEN JOBS FOR YOUTH PACT



ALMOST EVERY JOB IS ABOUT TO CHANGE

40% of all jobs are at risk due to climate change as they depend on industries reliant on a healthy climate and ecosystem.

Investments aimed at reaching net zero carbon emissions by 2050, hold the potential to create **8.4 million jobs for young people by 2030.**

These investments encompass crucial sectors such as:

- ▶ Clean and renewable energy
- ▶ Construction
- ▶ Sustainable agriculture
- ▶ Recycling and waste management

A BOLD NEW PACT FOR THE FUTURE

ILO, UNEP, and UNICEF are collaborating with young people, governments, the private sector, social partners, and education partners to accelerate commitments towards green jobs for youth, fostering a just transition and promoting sustainable economies.

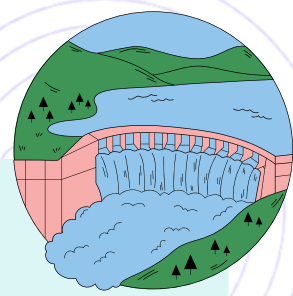
By 2030 the Pact aims to:

- ▶ Create 1 million new green jobs for youth, with a particular focus on young women;
- ▶ Accelerate the greening of 1 million existing jobs;
- ▶ Support 10,000 young entrepreneurs to establish and/or grow sustainable green businesses, while contributing to the creation of green jobs for their peers

STAKEHOLDERS CALL TO ACTION

► POLICYMAKERS/ GOVERNMENTS
