
Establishing a National Coordinating body for joint implementation Basel, Rotterdam, Stockholm and Minamata Conventions in the Republic of Serbia




- ► Goal of work this body is to be strengthened coordination and cooperation:
- between Competent authorities responsible for implementing provisions of the BRSM conventions
- ▶ adoption of Programm of work for implementation joint prioriry activities (such as Joint inspection plan, Awarness Raising Plan, Legislative Plan, etc., Data Management Plan for NIP updating and Reporting, etc)

Coordination body would have and supervisory role over monitoring realization policy and plans documents related to BRS-M conventiions


NCM Structure
